We did not audit the financial statement / financial information of One subsidiary included in the consolidated financial results, whose financial statement / financial information reflect Group's share of total revenues of Rs. 1,589.50 Lakhs and Rs. 12,788.44 Lakhs, Group's share of total net profit after tax of Rs. 7.13 Lakhs and Rs. 185.01 Lakhs, Group's share of total comprehensive profit of Rs. 7.13 Lakhs and Rs. 185.01 Lakhs, for the quarter ended 31st December 2023, and for the period from 01st April 2023 to 31st December 2023, respectively as considered in the consolidated financial results. This financial statement / financial information has been audited by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion on the consolidated financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiary is based solely on the reports of the other auditor and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph above.

Our opinion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matters

b. (13.58) Lakhs, Group's share of total comprehensive profit (loss) of Rs. 3.67 Lakhs and Rs. (13.58) Lakhs, for the quarter ended 31st December 2023 and for the period from 01st April 2023 to 31st December 2023, respectively, as considered in the Statement. These unaudited interim financial results and other unaudited financial information have been approved and furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the affairs of these subsidiaries is based solely on such unaudited interim financial results and other unaudited financial information. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial results are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion is not modified in respect of this matter.
